In 1966, gunsmith Harry Sanford set out to create a gun that would combine the big-bore stopping power of a .44 magnum with the accuracy and dependability of the

finest target pistol. The result was the legendary .44 AMP Automag, which was first introduced for sale to the public in 1971. Over the next decade the gun would develop a cult-like following as the Aristocrat of handguns. Unfortunately, rising production costs, resulting from the gun's complex design and high number of parts, forced an end to production in 1982.

Still, the legend of the .44 Automag continued to grow. The Automag gained national prominence in 1983 when a special Automag was built for Clint Eastwood to carry as Dirty Harry in the movie "Sudden Impact." Years later, American Handgunner featured a .44 Automag on the cover of its 20th Anniversary Issue, noting that it "embodies both the spirit and the

genius that characterizes the American handgun industry."

### RELIVE THE LEGEND

In 1996 the shooting world mourned the death of Harry Sanford, considered by many to be both a pioneer and a maverick of the modern firearms industry. To honor the life of this industry legend, Automag, Inc., is proud to announce the limited production of 1000 Harry Sanford Commemorative Automags.

limited production number will appear on the gun. Each firearm comes in an attractive custom walnut wood display case with the original Automag logo engraved on top.

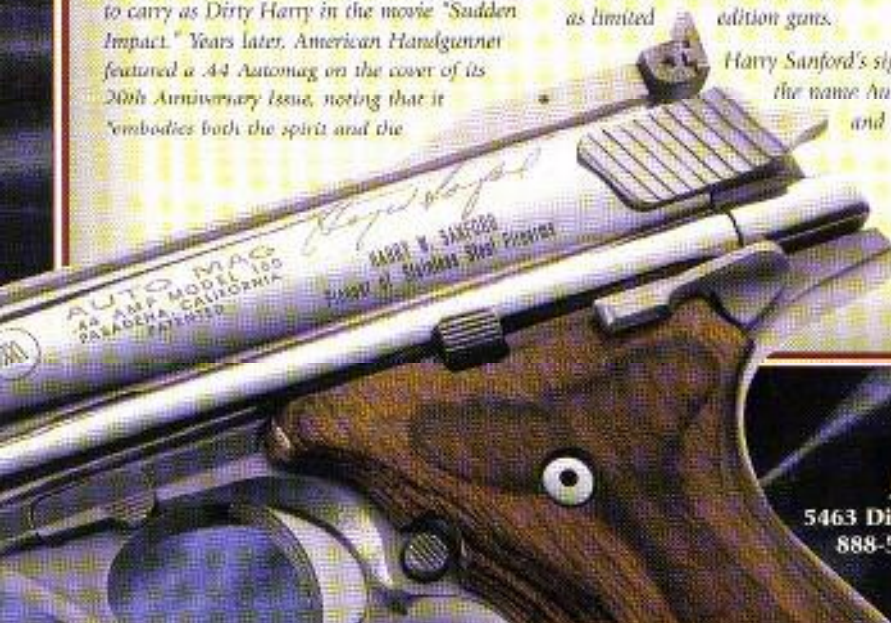
